



Notice of Examination for the Position of Police Officer



The Home Rule Borough of Edinboro will be conducting a Civil Service Examination for the purpose of establishing a list of eligible candidates for the position of Full-Time Police Officer.

The preliminary eligibility examinations (Physical Agility Examination and Written Examination) will be administered on Saturday, May 14th, 2022. The testing will be conducted “Locally” and all candidates interested in taking the Civil Service Examination for the position of Full-Time Police Officer will be required to obtain an application from the Home Rule Borough of Edinboro, Manager’s Office, 124 Meadville St., Edinboro, PA 16412 and submit the application with a \$60.00 fee. Applications will be available on Monday, March 21st, 2022 @ 9:00 AM or contact the Manager’s Office at 814-734-1812, ext. 123 to have an application mailed or emailed to you, as well as, for general questions about the examination process. All applications must be submitted at the Borough Manager’s Office, 124 Meadville St., Edinboro, PA 16412 by the deadline of 3:00 PM on Monday, May 2nd, 2022.

All candidates shall meet all general qualifications (see below) for police testing prior to any application being accepted by the Home Rule Borough of Edinboro. All applicants accepted will be eligible to take the Physical Agility Examination, to be administered on May 14th, 2022 @ 10:00 AM, which will be graded as a pass/fail and all candidates that pass the Physical Agility Examination will be eligible to take the Written Examination, which will be given on this same date, May 14th, 2022 @ 12:00 PM. The top (8) eligible candidates that chose to continue with the examination process will be offered an oral examination at a later date, yet to be determined.

Applicants must meet the following requirements at the time the application is submitted:

- 1.) Be a Citizen of the United States
- 2.) At least 21 years of age
- 3.) Possess a diploma from an accredited high school or a graduate equivalency diploma (GED)
- 4.) Possess a valid Motor Vehicle License issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5.) Either two (2) Full Years Municipality-Related Police Officer Experience OR an Associate’s Degree in a Police Related Field at an accredited institution of higher education OR sixty (60) semester credit hours in a Police Related Field at an accredited institution of higher education OR a Bachelor’s Degree in a Police Related Field at an accredited institution of higher education.
- 6.) Be Act 120 Certified under the Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Act Commission or shall have successfully completed the Act 120 Training and the final exam, thus being eligible for Act 120 Certification once hired.
- 7.) Applicants from another state must have completed the Pennsylvania MPOETC requirements and successfully passed the MPOETC Certification Exam, thus being eligible for Act 120 Certification upon being hired.
 - ◆ Location of the above-mentioned preliminary eligibility examinations will be given to each candidate that receives an application, along with the Physical Agility Testing Components.
