

CDBG PUBLIC HEARING
Borough of Edinboro
December 11, 2023

Welcome to the Public Hearing:

Mayor Gast opened the public hearing at 6:26 PM. Council members present were Mary Ann Horne, Aaron Gast, Pat Davis, Jim Kiley, Mark Eisert, and Amanda Frantz-Mamani. Absent was Spencer Larson. Also present were CDBG Administrator Tony Cunningham, Borough Manager Jason Spangenberg, Solicitor Tim Wachter, Mary Ann Mook, Curtis Hals, Gretchen Schlosser, Leah Therasse, Ray Overholt, MJ Campbell, Harry Glunt, David Glunt, and Ryan Parker.

Purpose of Hearing:

This public hearing is to revise previously-approved plans for 2022 CDBG funds. No comments were received prior to this hearing.

Discussion:


Tony Cunningham stated that the Borough had previously designated 2022 CDBG funds to be used for single family home rehabilitation, with the intent to revise to another project when such project was determined. The Borough intends now to allocate the 2022 CDBG funds for Phase 2 of the Nature's Outlet Improvement project, to be completed in 2024. The total amount of 2022 funds available for this project is \$95,752. With the allocated 2023 funds as well, there will be sufficient CDBG funds to cover the estimated cost for Nature's Outlet Phase 2 of \$171,314.

Brief discussion took place regarding the specifics of the CDBG program and the Nature's Outlet project. Manager Spangenberg stated that he would prepare a resolution for Council to approve this change at the January 2 meeting.
