

CDBG PUBLIC HEARING
Borough of Edinboro
November 14, 2022

Welcome to the Public Hearing:

Mayor Gast opened the public hearing at 6:18 PM. Council members present were Mary Ann Horne, Aaron Gast, Pat Davis, Jim Kiley, Mark Eisert, and Amanda Frantz-Mamani. Absent was Spencer Larson. Also present were Borough Manager Jason Spangenberg, Mary Ann Mook, Curtis Hals, Shawn Wroblewski, Stephen Skaines, Phyllis Woods, Renee Thayer-Allison, Nancy Crawford, Amy Adamski, Kathy Jamison, John Stachowiak, Janet Stachowiak, Nickolas Hope, Kurt Hopkins, Marshall Piccinini, Cathy Hutchison, and Mark Hutchison.

Purpose of Hearing:

This public hearing is to revise previously-approved plans for 2019, 2020, and 2021 CDBG funds. Notice of hearing appeared in the Erie Times News on June 29, 2022 as well as posted on the Borough's website. No comments were received prior to this hearing.


Discussion:

Manager Spangenberg stated that unused funds from fiscal years 2019 and 2020 would be allocated to Phase 1 of the Nature's Outlet Improvement project, and the portion of 2021 funds which has been allocated to make ADA improvements near Pat Crawford Beach would be reallocated toward the Nature's Outlet project. Total CDBG funds available for Phase 1 would be about \$150,000 with the project budgeted at about \$210,000. Renee Thayer-Allison asked how the balance of the project would be funded. Manager Spangenberg replied that he has applied for a \$50,000 ECGRA Parks Grant, and any remaining amount would be from Borough monies.
