

**BOROUGH OF EDINBORO  
RESOLUTION NO. 15-2021**

A **RESOLUTION**, of the Home Rule Borough of Edinboro, Erie County, Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the year 2022.

**WHEREAS**, PA Act 51 of 2019 authorized the use of a Resolution rather than an Ordinance for setting the annual tax levy if keeping the same tax rate or lowering it; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Edinboro intends to set the same tax levy in 2022 as in 2021.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Edinboro that a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within the Borough as follows: Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 4.50 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, which equates to \$450 per \$100,000 of assessed value. Also, the Homestead Act enacted by Ordinance 555 shall be in effect for the year 2022 as it has been since 2008.

The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:

	Mills on Each Dollar of Assessed Valuation
Tax Rate for General Purposes	4.50 Mills

That any ordinance/resolution, or part of ordinance/resolution, conflicting with this resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this resolution.
